Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Northeast corner of Lot 915 and on the South side of "Road 12", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 16070.2 feet South and 262.7 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2650, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 265° 40' 1601.8 feet along the South side of "Road 12" to an iron pipe;
2. 28° 58' 152.0 feet along the Northwest side of "Road A" to a stake;
3. 119° 41' 112.4 feet along camp site No. 5-A to a stake;
4. 29° 41' 499.6 feet along same to a stake;
5. 299° 41' 116.9 feet along same to a stake;
6. 29° 41' 60.4 feet along the Northwest side of "Road A" to an iron pipe;
7. 119° 41' 10.0 feet along same to an iron pipe;
8. 29° 41' 423.5 feet along same to an iron pipe;
9. 300° 51' 10.0 feet along same to an iron pipe;
10. 32° 02' 317.0 feet along same to an iron pipe;
11. 85° 40' 783.8 feet along Lot 1001-B to an iron pipe;
12. 175° 40' 1200.0 feet along Lot 915 to the point of beginning.
