Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Northeast corner of Lot 917 and on the South side of "Road 12", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 16217.0 feet South and 2200.6 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2650, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 265° 40' 968.0 feet along the South side of "Road 12" to an iron pipe;
2. 355° 40' 1200.0 feet along Lot 915 to an iron pipe;
3. 85° 40' 968.0 feet along Lot 1003 to an iron pipe;
4. 175° 40' 1200.0 feet along Lot 917 to the point of beginning.

AREA 26-67/100 ACRES.

Excepting and reserving therefrom the Government Survey Trig. Station "Camp 6" and a lot 50 feet square surrounding same, (Area 06/100 Acre), together with the right to enter upon said lot and to occupy said Trig. Station LEAVING A NET AREA OF 26-61/100 ACRES.
