Waiakea, South Hilo, Hawaii

Being a portion of the Government (Crown) Land of Waiakea

Being also the railroad right-of-way reserved and excluded
from Grant 9371 to John Todd or his heirs.

Beginning at the southwest corner of this parcel of land and on the
boundary between Lots 904 and 905 of Waiakea Homesteads, 1st. Series, the coordinates
of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station
"HALAI" being 17253.55 feet South and 7673.50 feet East, as shown on Government Survey
Registered Map 2600, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 175° 40' 20.14 feet across the Abandoned Railroad Right-of-way;
2. 272° 20' 348.07 feet along Grant 9371 to John Todd or his heirs
(Lot 904 of Waiakea Homesteads, 1st. Series);
3. 85° 40' 172.28 feet along Grant 9335 to Mrs. Alice Hamilton
(Lot 906 of Waiakea Homesteads, 1st. Series);
4. 92° 20' 174.63 feet along Grant 9371 to John Todd or his heirs
(Lot 904 of Waiakea Homesteads, 1st. Series),
to the point of beginning and containing an
Area of 0.12 Acre.
