Beginning at a galvanized iron pipe at the Southeast corner of Lot 3 and the Southwest corner of Lot 2, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kepuhi" being 8035.0 feet North and 4711.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2408, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 108° 16' 2599.0 feet along Forest Reserve to a galvanized iron pipe at the Southwest corner of Lot 4;
2. 176° 25' 848.0 feet along Lot 5, crossing gulch to a point on the North side of said gulch;
3. 280° 52' 52.5 feet along near top edge of gulch to a stake;
4. 287° 37' 743.0 feet along same to a stake;
5. 305° 06' 414.0 feet along same to a stake;
6. 295° 28' 150.0 feet along same to a stake;
7. 227° 11' 287.0 feet along same to a stake;
8. 240° 40' 490.0 feet along same to a stake;
9. 255° 46' 560.0 feet along same to a stake;
10. 356° 25' 1699.4 feet along Lot 2, crossing gulch and up slope to the point of beginning.
