A noncandidate committee that makes independent expenditures in an aggregate amount of more than \$500 within the period between fourteen and four calendar days prior to the <u>Special Election</u> shall file a Late Expenditures Report. <u>The reports are not required if there are no late contributions or late expenditures.</u> Note: Late contributions and late expenditures will also be reported on the Final Election Period Report.) **At the conclusion of the Special Election on April 13, 2019, noncandidate committees must continue to electronically file reports in the Noncandidate Committee Filing System until their final disclosure report has no surplus or deficit, and a request to terminate is submitted to and approved by the Commission. The first report due after the Special Election is the Supplemental Report covering the reporting period of April 14 through June 30, 2019. This report is due on July 31, 2019.**
