A noncandidate committee that makes independent expenditures in an aggregate amount of more than \$500 within the period between fourteen and four calendar days prior to the <u>Primary Election</u> shall file a Late Expenditures Report. <u>The reports are not required if there are no late contributions or late expenditures.</u> Note: Late contributions and late expenditures will also be reported on the Final Primary Report.) A noncandidate committee that makes independent expenditures in an aggregate amount of more than \$500 within the period between fourteen and four calendar days prior to the <u>General Election</u> shall file a Late Expenditures Report. <u>The reports are not required if there are no late contributions or late expenditures.</u> Note: Late contributions and late expenditures will also be reported on the Final Election Period Report.) ALERT

At the conclusion of the General Election on November 3, 2020, noncandidate committees still registered with the Campaign Spending Commission (“Commission”) must continue to electronically file reports in the Noncandidate Committee Filing System until their final disclosure report has no surplus or deficit, and a request to terminate is submitted to and approved by the Commission. The first report due after the General Election is the Supplemental Report covering the reporting period of November 4 through December 31, 2020. This report is due on February 1, 2021.
