

**SCHEDULE OF REPORTING DATES FOR
2020 ELECTION CANDIDATES NOT RUNNING IN THE 2022 ELECTION**
(November, 2020)

At the conclusion of the 2020 election period on November 3, 2020, candidate committees with a surplus or deficit must continue reporting with the Commission until the surplus has been disbursed or the deficit has been cleared. This reporting schedule must be followed if a candidate has no current plans of running, and until a final Supplemental Report reflecting no surplus or deficit has been filed and the Commission approves a signed "Request for Termination of Registration" form. If nomination papers are filed to run in the 2022 election, the candidate must follow the reporting schedule for candidates that are running in that election.
