**REPORTING DEADLINES**

□ July 29, 2022	Deadline to file Organizational Report stating intent to not receive contributions, or make expenditures, that aggregate more than \$1,000 in the 2022 election period (November 4, 2020-November 8, 2022) (\$1,000 or less noncandidate committees need not file the preliminary and final primary reports, and the preliminary general reports but are only required to file the Final Election Period report due December 8, 2022.)	
□ August 3, 2022	February 27-July 29, 2022	Preliminary Primary
□ August 10, 2022	July 30-August 9, 2022 (A noncandidate committee that makes contributions aggregating more than \$500, or receives contributions from any person aggregating more than \$500, within the period of fourteen calendar days through four calendar days prior to the <u>Primary Election</u> shall file a Late Contributions Report. A noncandidate committee that makes independent expenditures in an aggregate amount of more than \$500 within the period between fourteen and four calendar days prior to the <u>Primary Election</u> shall file a Late Expenditures Report. <u>The reports, which are filed together in the filing system, are not required if there are no late contributions and late expenditures.</u> Note: Late contributions and late expenditures will also be reported on the Final Primary Report.) □ September 2, 2022	July 30-August 13, 2022	Final Primary
□ October 3, 2022	August 14-September 26, 2022	1 <sup>st</sup> Preliminary General
□ October 31, 2022	September 27-October 24, 2022	2 <sup>nd</sup> Preliminary General
□ November 7, 2022	October 25-November 4, 2022 (A noncandidate committee that makes contributions aggregating more than \$500, or receives contributions from any person aggregating more than \$500, within the period of fourteen calendar days through four calendar days prior to the <u>General Election</u> shall file a Late Contributions Report. A noncandidate committee that makes independent expenditures in an aggregate amount of more than \$500 within the period between fourteen and four calendar days prior to the <u>General Election</u> shall file a Late Expenditures Report. <u>The reports, which are filed together in the filing system, are not required if there are no late contributions and late expenditures.</u> Note: Late contributions and late expenditures will also be reported on the Final Election Period Report.)	Late Contributions/Expenditures
□ December 8, 2022	October 25-November 8, 2022	Final Election Period
□ December 8, 2022	<u>or</u> February 27-November 8, 2022 (For noncandidate committees who filed the Organizational Report by the July 29, 2022 deadline stating their intent to not receive contributions, or make expenditures, that aggregate more than \$1,000 in the election period for the 2022 election.)	Final Election Period

**ALERT**

**At the conclusion of the General Election on November 8, 2022, noncandidate committees still registered with the Campaign Spending Commission (“Commission”) must continue to electronically file reports in the Noncandidate Committee Filing System until their final disclosure report has no surplus or deficit, and a request to terminate is submitted to and approved by the Commission. The first report due after the General Election is the Supplemental Report covering the reporting period of November 7 through December 31, 2022. This report is due on January 31, 2023.**
