<input type="checkbox"/> July 24, 2026	Deadline to file Organizational Report stating intent to not receive contributions, or make expenditures, that aggregate more than \$1,000 in the 2024 election period (November 6, 2024-November 3, 2026) (\$1,000 or less noncandidate committees need not file the preliminary and final primary reports, and the preliminary general reports but are only required to file the Final Election Period report due December 3, 2026.)

<input type="checkbox"/> August 5, 2026	July 25-August 4, 2026 (A noncandidate committee that receives contributions from any person aggregating more than \$500, receives donations individually or aggregating more than \$10,000 during an election period from a donor providing consent to a 501(c)(4) nonprofit organization operating as a noncandidate committee, or makes contributions aggregating more than \$500 to candidates on the Primary Election ballot within the period of fourteen calendar days through four calendar days prior to the <u>Primary Election</u> shall file a Late Contributions Report. A noncandidate committee that makes independent expenditures in an aggregate amount of more than \$500 within the period between fourteen and four calendar days prior to the <u>Primary Election</u> shall file a Late Expenditures Report. <u>The reports are not required if there are no late contributions or late expenditures.</u> Note: Late contributions and late expenditures will also be reported on the Final Primary Report.) <input type="checkbox"/> November 2, 2026	October 20-October 30, 2026 (A noncandidate committee that receives contributions from any person aggregating more than \$500, receives donations individually or aggregating more than \$10,000 during an election period from a donor providing consent to a 501(c)(4) nonprofit organization operating as a noncandidate committee, or makes contributions aggregating more than \$500 to candidates on the General Election ballot within the period of fourteen calendar days through four calendar days prior to the <u>General Election</u> shall file a Late Contributions Report. A noncandidate committee that makes independent expenditures in an aggregate amount of more than \$500 within the period between fourteen and four calendar days prior to the <u>General Election</u> shall file a Late Expenditures Report. <u>The reports are not required if there are no late contributions or late expenditures.</u> Note: Late contributions and late expenditures will also be reported on the Final Election Period Report.) ALERT

At the conclusion of the General Election on November 3, 2026, noncandidate committees still registered with the Campaign Spending Commission (“Commission”) must continue to electronically file reports in the Noncandidate Committee Filing System until their final disclosure report has no surplus or deficit, and a request to terminate is submitted to and approved by the Commission. The first report due after the General Election is the Supplemental Report covering the reporting period of November 4 through December 31, 2026. This report is due on February 1, 2027.
