STATEMENT OF INFORMATION FOR
ELECTIONEERING COMMUNICATION
(*Noncandidate Committees and Individuals only)

For any person who will be broadcasting from a cable, satellite, television, or radio broadcast station; publishing in any periodical or newspaper or by electronic means which includes Facebook boosts, Google ads, other social media, or email; or sending by mail any advertisement that refers to a clearly identifiable candidate and contains an appeal to vote for or against a candidate in the upcoming election, you must file a Statement of Information for Electioneering Communication ("Statement") within 24 hours of the first date in the calendar year on which an electioneering communication is publicly distributed, if the expenditures for electioneering communications in the calendar year is more than \$2,000 aggregate and the electioneering communication is distributed either within **30 days before a primary or initial special election (i.e., July 9, 2026 to August 8, 2026)** or within **60 days before a general or special election (i.e., September 4, 2026 to November 3, 2026)**. For electioneering communications that are publicly distributed via mail ("Mailers"), the Statement must be filed within 24 hours of the date the Mailers are first mailed. See, Hawaii Revised Statutes §11-341.

Once you file an initial Statement to disclose electioneering communications of more than \$2,000 aggregate, additional Statements are required to be filed within 24 hours of the date of any subsequent electioneering communication that is publicly distributed regardless of amount. Persons who fail to file the Statement or fail to timely file the Statement within the required 24 hours, will be in violation of the campaign finance laws.

*This form must be filed in addition to the filing of any other report required by noncandidate committees.
