Beginning at a red-wood post at the Southwest corner of this piece, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Laina" being 4740.0 feet South and 6201.6 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2414, and running by true azimuth

1. $169^{\circ} 34'$ 149.6 feet along Government land (Baseball Lot) to a 3x4 post;
2. $196^{\circ} 32'$ 727.1 feet along Government land (Papiha Cemetery) to a monkey-pod tree;
3. $297^{\circ} 18'$ 179.9 feet along the South bank of Alamihi Stream to a red-wood post;
4. $7^{\circ} 35'$ 711.0 feet along L.C.A. 3702 to D. Malo to a red-wood post;
5. $72^{\circ} 50'$ 168.7 feet along L.C.A. 277 to C. Kanaina no W.C. Lunalilo to a red-wood post;
6. $85^{\circ} 10'$ 85.0 feet along L.C.A. 277 to C. Kanaina no W.C. Lunalilo to the point of beginning.
