1. $275^{\circ} 53'$ 137.5 feet along Government Road to a \dagger on a stone;
2. $5^{\circ} 53'$ 139.1 feet along Lot 3, Block A;
3. $98^{\circ} 41'$ 134.1 feet along swamp;
4. $184^{\circ} 21'$ 132.7 feet along Lot 1 to the point of beginning.
