2. $98^{\circ} 41'$ 116.6 feet along swamp;
3. $185^{\circ} 53'$ 139.1 feet along Lot 2, Block A, to a + on a stone;
4. $275^{\circ} 53'$ 126.7 feet along the Government Road to the point of beginning.
