1.  $282^{\circ} 42'$  166.0 feet along Government Road to a  $\dagger$  on a stone;
2.  $14^{\circ} 47'$  117.8 feet along Lot 9, Block A;
3.  $106^{\circ} 25'$  140.9 feet along swamp;
4.  $181^{\circ} 42'$  110.7 feet along Lot 7, Block A, to the point of beginning.
