Notes of Survey.

Commencing at the North West corner of this lot near an Ahu Pohaku at a point marked by a post the coordinates of which are 1211 ft. South and 11013 ft. West from H. G. S. Triangulation Station at the Opihilala Church, the Boundary runs thence by true meridian:

- S 76° 14' E 1709 feet to a point on the West bank of a great Gulch marked by a pride of India tree, thence,
- S 00° 22' E 990 feet up to a point in bottom of said Gulch,
- N 78° 30' W 229.5 feet along lot VII, thence,
- N 32° 10' E 356 feet along lot VI, thence,
- N 31° 54' E 743.6 feet along lot 1 a and lot II and lot 2a to

the Point of commencement and containing an area of 45 3/4 Acres, a little more or less.

Note. In descriptions where trees or the corner mark is because it was on said land the original survey bearing of line of corner posts.
