Beginning at a \perp in stone, marked by an ahu, on the Eastern boundary of Grant 3153 to Mikia and Keaweikaliko, which is the Southwest corner of this lot and the Northwest corner of Lot 3, the coordinates from Puu Nahaha Δ being N 25622.0 feet, E 8913.4 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2171, and running by true bearings:-

1. N $14^{\circ} 00'$ W 1054.2 feet along Grant 3153 to Mikia and Keaweikaliko, to ahu;
2. N $79^{\circ} 30'$ E 24508.6 feet along Lot 1 to ahu on Kahuku Boundary, the coordinates from Pualehua Δ being S 4863.7 feet W 2146.2 feet;
3. S $45^{\circ} 03'$ ^E 1277.5 feet along Kahuku to ahu at Northeast corner Lot 3;
4. S $79^{\circ} 30'$ W 25168.7 feet along Lot 3 to initial point.
