Beginning at a + on stone at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Southwest corner of Lot 1-A, and on the East boundary of L.C.A.4731 Apana 3, to Makuakane, from which point of beginning "Makua" Trig. Station is by true azimuth and distance $161^{\circ} 40'$ 66.0 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No.2464, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $265^{\circ} 25'$ 165.5 feet along Lot 1-A to redwood post;
2. $263^{\circ} 28'$ 132.0 feet along L.C.A.4547 Apana 1, to Anahola;
3. $355^{\circ} 28'$ 88.4 feet along same;
4. $84^{\circ} 39'$ 300.7 feet along Lots 4-A and 3-A;
5. $177^{\circ} 40'$ 88.0 feet along L.C.A.4731 Apana 3, to Makuakane, to the point of beginning.
