Beginning at a red-wood post (J.S.E.) and pile of stones at the Southwest corner of this lot and the common corner of the lands of Upolu and Kukuipahu, said point being 7222.6 feet South and 6287.3 feet East of Government Survey Trig. Station "Kehoni", as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2495, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 140° 13' 30" 1974.0 feet along the land of Upolu to a post;
2. 243° 22' 00" 216.0 feet along the old Mahukona Road to a post;
3. 324° 00' 00" 1994.8 feet along Lot 2 to a post;
4. 89° 21' 30" 106.0 feet along the land of Kukuipahu to the point of beginning.

Total Area 6-80/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a right of way for the Kohala Ditch through this lot, said ditch containing an area of 15/100 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 6-65/100 ACRES.
