Beginning at a + on set stone and ahu at the Northeast corner of this lot and the Northwest corner of Lot 5 on the South side of a 15 foot road, the co-ordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Akahipuu" being 7433.0 feet South and 3659.0 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2431, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 359° 00' 474.5 feet along stonewall along Lot 5 to a point 13.5 feet South of present wall corner;
2. 90° 40' 745.5 feet along the North side of a 20 foot road to a point 28.0 feet South of present wall corner;
3. 180° 10' 490.5 feet along stone wall along Lot 3 to a + on set stone and ahu;
4. 271° 57' 736.0 feet along the South side of a 15 foot road to the point of beginning.

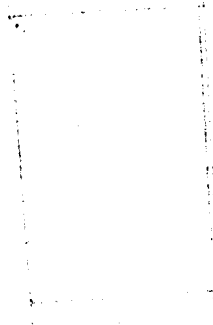

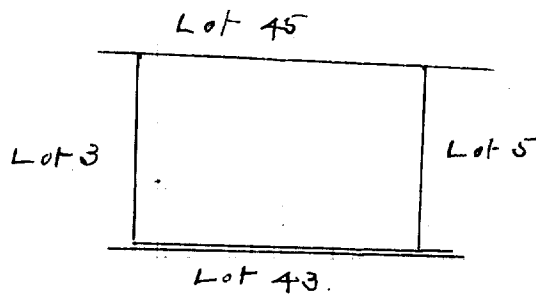
Description of Lot 4.

Haleohia North Kona Hawaii

Beginning at the N.W. corner of Lot 5, and running as follows by line bearings.

1. N 88° 00 W. 736 ft along Lot 45,
2. South 490 " " " B,
3. S 89 20 E. 732 " " 20ft Roadway,
4. North 470 " " Lot 5 to the initial point and containing an area of $8\frac{2}{10}$ acres.
