4. 80° 17' 144.3 feet along Lot 5-A to + on stone;
5. 78° 40' 30.0 feet along L.C.A. 4621 Apana 3, to Pehuiki, to + on stone;
6. 174° 39' 168.7 feet along Lot 3-A to the initial point.
