Alika Homestead Lots.

Lot 5.

Beginning at a  $\dagger$  in stone, marked by an ahu, on the North Boundary of Papa Homesteads, which is the Southwest corner of this lot and the Southeast corner of Grant 3153 to Mikia and Keaweikaliko, the coordinates from Pau Nahaha  $\triangle$  being N 22474.5 feet, E 9698.2 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2171, and running by true bearings:-

1. N  $14^{\circ} 00'$  W 1214.3 feet along Grant 3153 to Mikia and Keaweikaliko to ahu;
2. N  $79^{\circ} 30'$  E 26439.7 feet along Lot 4 to ahu an Kahuku Boundary;
3. S  $45^{\circ} 05'$  E 1183.5 feet along Kahuku Boundary to ahu on Papa I Boundary the coordinates from Pualehua  $\triangle$  being S 7503.9 feet, W 498.7 feet;
4. S  $79^{\circ} 30'$  W 26506.0 feet along Papa I to ahu at Northeast corner of Papa Homesteads;
5. S  $55^{\circ} 20'$  W 579.6 feet along Papa Homesteads to initial point.

Reserving however from the above a 40 foot roadway near the Western boundary of this lot, and leaving a net area of 599.0 acres.
