Beginning at a spike in rock at the Southwest corner of this lot, the Southeast corner of Lot 4 and on the North boundary of Alae I (Grant 2036 to Beniamina), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Pahoehoe" being ~~3052.9~~^{3393.4} feet South, and ~~988.2~~^{988.1} feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2702, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 179° 35' 412.1 feet along Lot 4 to a pipe in ahu;
2. 264° 20' 578.0 feet along Haukalua I (Grant 1970 to Kalaaukane) to an iron pin in ahu;
3. 359° 35' 385.0 feet along Lot 6 to an iron pin;
4. 81° 40' 581.1 feet along Alae I (Grant 2036 to Beniamina) to the point of beginning.

Area 5-27/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a road 30 feet wide along the South boundary of this lot, as shown on plan hereto attached and made a part hereof, Area 40/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 4-87/100 ACRES.
