Description of Lot 5.

Waiaha II, North Kona, Hawaii.

Beginning at the S.E. corner of Lot 4 from which point "Puu Kehoe" Trig. Station bears  $N 88^{\circ} 27' E$ , <sup>the</sup> 1130.0 feet and running as follows by true bearings:-

1.  $N 61^{\circ} 20' E$  2300.0 feet along Kahului II;
2.  $N 50^{\circ} 35' W$  710.0 " " I (Gov't);
3.  $S 60^{\circ} 40' W$  2200.0 " Waiaha I;
4.  $S 22^{\circ} 35' E$  1035.0 " Lot 4 to the initial point and containing an area of 43 acres:

The rights of Native Kuleanas reserved also 30 ft. roadways as shown on map.
