Survey setting off 2 acres of land from the South end of " Reserved Lot No. 6" of Homestead lands in Kaauhuhu, for Robert Laing; the road on its W. side being laid off at 30 ft. wide, as apparently intended in the original survey, and the fences now running along the roads being subject to change, to make them agree with the lines of the Government survey.

Begin at the assumed S. corner of Lot #6, at junction of roads and run true azimuths as follows:

1. - $188^{\circ}45'$ 204.5 ft. down E. side of road to Hawi,
2. - $192^{\circ}43'$ 179. " " " " " " " "
3. - $272^{\circ}15'$ 445.8 " across Lot # 6 to stake 16 ft. S. from Post on W. side of another road, this post being between Lots 5 and 6,
4. - $21^{\circ}49'$ 71.4 ft to cor. of fence,
5. - $72^{\circ}50'$ 208. " " " " "
6. - $47^{\circ}58'$ 235.6 " " Post on S. side of Lot 6, by fence,
7. - $57^{\circ}11'$ 138.5 " " point of beginning,

comprising 87.120 sq. ft., or 2.0 Acres, more or less.

- 2.— $192^{\circ} 43'$ 179.00 feet down east side of road to Hawaii;
- 3.— $272^{\circ} 15'$ 445.80 feet across Lot 6 to stake 16 feet South from post \square on west side of another road, this post being between Lots 5 and 6;
- 4.— $29^{\circ} 49'$ 71.40 feet to corner of fence;
- 5.— $72^{\circ} 50'$ 208.00 feet to corner of fence;
- 6.— $47^{\circ} 58'$ 235.60 feet to post \square on South side of Lot 6 by fence;
7. $57^{\circ} 11'$ 138.50 feet to point of beginning.
