Beginning at a 1½ inch galvanized iron pipe in concrete on the East bank of ditch ~~and~~ ^{East} the ~~West~~ side of the Government Road and being the Southwest corner of this lot, from which Trig. Station "Bluff" is by true azimuth and distance 100° 54' 409.6 feet and Trig. Station "Makua" is by true azimuth 219° 31' and the Church Spire is 328° 36' 30", as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2464, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 172° 04' 324.8 feet along East bank of ditch;
2. 276° 52' 306.6 feet along L.C.A. 4730:1 to Manamana;
3. 3° 43' 329.1 feet along the bank of the Anahola Stream to + on stone;
4. 99° 15' 28.7 feet along Government Road to a red-wood post;
5. 182° 32' 132.0 feet along L.C.A. 5023:1 to Kolia;
6. 88° 32' 118.7 feet along L.C.A. 5023:1 to Kolia;
7. 350° 33' 113.9 feet along L.C.A. 5023:1 to Kolia;
8. 100° 58' 117.8 feet along Government Road to the point of beginning.
