Beginning at a + on the East face of a stonewall at the North-west corner of this lot and the Northeast corner of Lot 7 on the South boundary of Grant 1870 to Hewahewa, the co-ordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Akahipuu" being 7393.0 feet South and 1326.0 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2431, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 273° 35' 47.3 feet along Grant 1870 to Hewahewa to a + on rock on old iwi and wire fence;
2. 285° 30' 80.0 feet along Grant 1870 along fence on old iwi;
3. 282° 20' 67.0 feet along Grant 1870 along fence on old iwi;
4. 265° 00' 139.0 feet along Grant 1870 along fence on old iwi;
5. 268° 00' 100.0 feet along Grant 1870 along fence on old iwi;
6. 265° 45' 251.0 feet along Grant 1870 along fence on old iwi;
7. 255° 00' 38.0 feet along Grant 1870 along fence to a wall corner;
8. 359° 20' 525.0 feet along stonewall along Lot 9 to corner of wall;
9. 89° 50' 4.0 feet along North side of a 20 foot road to a + on set stone;
10. 96° 00' 713.0 feet along North side of a 20 foot road to a + on stone in wall 13.5 feet North of present wall corner;
11. 178° 53' 444.0 feet along stonewall along Lot 7 to point of beginning.

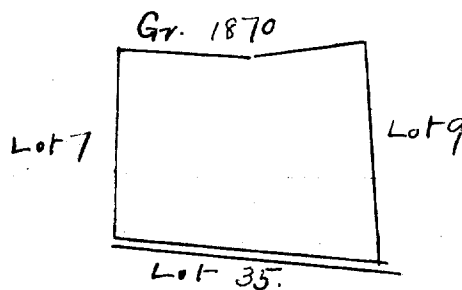

2. N. $82^{\circ} 40' E.$ 282 " " " "
3. S. $4^{\circ} 40' E.$ 080 " " Lot 9.
4. N. $84^{\circ} 00' W.$ 710 " " 20ft. Roadway.
5. North. 490 " " Lot 7 to the initial
point, and containing an
area of $8 \frac{00}{100}$ acres.
