Beginning at a + on set stone and ahu at the Southeast corner of this lot and the Southwest corner of Lot 7, on the boundary between the lands of Kealakehe and Keahuolu, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Keahuolu" being: 4845.4 feet North and 8905.3 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2122, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 78° 40' 1322.0 feet along the land of Keahuolu to a + on set stone and ahu;
2. 76° 50' 225.5 feet along the land of Keahuolu to a + on set stone and ahu;
3. 155° 06' 2251.6 feet along Lot 11 to a + on set stone and ahu;
4. 258° 37' 1548.0 feet along 50 foot road to a + on set stone and ahu, the same being the the Northwest corner of Lot 7;
5. 335° 06' 2245.7 feet along Lot 7 to the point of beginning.
