Beginning at a 1-1/2 inch galvanized pipe set in concrete at the Northeast corner of this lot, the Northwest corner of Lot 10-A and on the South boundary of L.C.A. 4621 Apana 3 to Pehuiki, from which point "Makua" Trig. Station is by true azimuth and distance 161° 23' 58.8 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2464, and running by true azimuths: -

1. 3° 02' 177.8 feet along Lots 10-A and 11-A to a + on a stone;
2. 99° 54' 163.0 feet along L.C.A. 4913 to Kanuha-Ma to a + on a stone;
3. 241° 30' 22.7 feet along same to a redwood post;
4. 182° 42' 132.0 feet along L.C.A. 4694 Apana 1 to Lono (elua) to a redwood post;
5. 220° 48' 23.1 feet along L.C.A. 4694 Apana 1 to Lono (elua) to a redwood post;
6. 358° 48' 6.6 feet along L.C.A. 4621, ^{to} Pehuiki to + on a stone;
7. 271° 49' 129.0 feet along L.C.A. 4621, ^{to} Pehuiki to the point of beginning.
