Beginning at an iron rail on the East side of Government Main Road adjoining the land of Kaonoulu, the coordinates of said iron rail referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu o Kali" being: 11482.2 feet North and 24425.8 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2516, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 274° 57' 171.5 feet along the land of Kaonoulu;
2. 215° 35' 548.0 feet along the land of Kaonoulu;
3. 275° 59' 1494.0 feet along the land of Kaonoulu;
4. 350° 36' 30" 360.0 feet along Lot 1, Waiohuli-Keokea Grazing Lots;
5. 83° 30' 50" 1993.2 feet along Lot 2, Waiohuli-Keokea Beach ~~Lots~~ *Hmts*, along Kalepolepo Church lot and 20 foot road;
6. 170° 00' 310.0 feet along Government Main Road to the point of beginning.

Beginning at a + cut on stone on the West side of Government Main Road, adjoining the land of Kaonoulu, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu o Kali" being: 11486.7 feet North and 24477.4 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2516, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 350° 00' 319.9 feet along Government Main Road;
2. 82° 37' 173.7 feet along Lot 2A, Waiohuli-Keokea Beach ^{lots} ~~lots~~;
3. 180° 06' 30" 347.5 feet along beach reserve;
4. 274° 57' 116.7 feet along the land of Kaonoulu to the point of beginning.
