Beginning at a 1½ inch galvanized iron pipe at the West corner of this lot, on the North boundary of Kalopa Camp Site and at the East end of Camp Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalaniai" being 8227.8 feet North and 2851.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 211° 00' 32.1 feet along end of Camp Road to a 1½ inch galvanized iron pipe, at the Southeast corner of Lot 2;
2. 211° 00' 879.0 feet along Lot 2 to 1½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
3. 294° 15' 959.0 feet along Government Reserve to a 1½ inch galvanized iron pipe at the top edge of Kalopa Gulch;
4. Thence following along the edge of Kalopa Gulch to a 1½ inch galvanized iron pipe, the direct azimuth and distance being: 25° 36' 641.3 feet;
5. 100° 10' 1083.6 feet along Kalopa Camp Site to the point of beginning.
