Anahola Lots, Koolau, Kauai.

Beginning at a + on a stone South of the ditch, being the ~~North~~ <sup>North</sup> corner of this lot and on the boundary of L.C.A. 4935 to Kolehaka, from which Government Survey Trig. Station "Naoleli" is by true azimuth and distance  $346^{\circ} 51' 717.3$  feet <sup>and</sup> Trig. Station "Bluff" is by true azimuth  $18^{\circ} 28'$  and the Native Church Spire is  $357^{\circ} 31' 30''$ , as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2464, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $344^{\circ} 53'$  530.7 feet along L.C.A. 4935 to Kolehaka;
2.  $339^{\circ} 41'$  31.4 feet along Right-of-Way to the Northeast corner of L.C.A. 5022:2 to Kunane;
3.  $90^{\circ} 54'$  159.5 feet along L.C.A. 5022:2 to Kunane;
4.  $167^{\circ} 47'$  16.5 feet along L.C.A. 5022:2, to Kunane;
5.  $164^{\circ} 45'$  343.2 feet along L.C.A. 4984 to Kale;
6.  $167^{\circ} 45'$  120.1 feet along L.C.A. 5022:3 to Kunane;
7.  $239^{\circ} 55'$  149.6 feet along the pali to the point of beginning.
