Beginning at a + on set stone and ahu at the Southeast corner of this lot, the West side of old government road and on the North side of 50 foot road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Keahuolu" being: 6276.3 feet North and 4700.4 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2122, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 78° 37' 1062.0 feet along 50 foot road to a + on pahoehoe and ahu;
2. 155° 06' 2292.0 feet along Lot 12B to a + on set stone and ahu;
3. 260° 05' 3223 feet along the land of Honokahau 2 to a + on pahoehoe and ahu;
4. 259° 50' 747.0 feet along the land of Honokahau 2 to a + on pahoehoe and ahu, the same being the West side of old government road;
5. 328° 20' 2358.5 feet along West side of old government road to the point of beginning.
