Beginning at a stone marked XIII under wall on the Northwest side of old road to Waimea at the West corner of this lot and the South corner of Lot 12, the true azimuth and distance to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kaipohaku" (marked by a spike in a rock) being:-
121° 25' 1050.0 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2430, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 33° 21' 632.5 feet along the Northwest side of old road to Waimea to XIII on solid rock at wall corner;
2. 120° 03' 500.0 feet along Lot 15 to wall corner;
3. 213° 39' 644.5 feet along Lot 14 to an angle in stonewall;
4. 301° 25' 496.0 feet along Lot 13 to the point of beginning.
