2. 33° 30' 351.5 feet along fence along school lot;
3. 35° 45' 123.0 feet along road to rock marked XVII;
4. 120° 13' 848.5 feet along fence along Lot 16 and across road to
rock marked XVI;
5. 204° 47' 674.5 feet along the East side of a 20 foot road to rock
marked XVII;
6. 301° 03' 941.5 feet along fence along Lot 18 to the point of
beginning.
