Beginning at a post at the ^{North} West corner of this lot, the Southwest corner of Lot 14, and on the Northeast side of a 30 foot road, the coordinates of said post referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Aku" being 3373.1 feet North and 243.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2479, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 270° 00' 824.7 feet along Lot 14 to a post at the Southwest corner of Grant 2504 to Puhalahua;
2. 347° 34' 529.1 feet along Grant 2117 to Mose Kekai to a post;
3. 90° 00' 662.3 feet along Lot 23 to a post on the East side of the 30 foot road;
4. 168° 20' 299.8 feet along 30 foot road to a post;
5. 135° 57' 310.4 feet along 30 foot road to the point of beginning.
