Anahola Lots, Koolau, Kauai.

Beginning at a + on a stone at the Southeast corner of this lot, the Northeast corner of Lot 19, the West corner of Lot 11, and the Northwest corner of L.C.A. 5022:2 to Kumane, from which Government Survey Trig. Station "Terrace" is by true azimuth and distance $237^{\circ} 14'$ 1416.1 feet, Trig. Station "Kikoo" is by true azimuth $105^{\circ} 28'$ and the Church Spire is $344^{\circ} 43'$, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2464, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $93^{\circ} 45'$ 131.0 feet along Lot 19 to + on stone;
2. $183^{\circ} 45'$ 117.2 feet along Government Road to + on stone;
3. $224^{\circ} 34'$ 114.0 feet along Trail to + on stone;
4. $318^{\circ} 47'$ 142.4 feet along L.C.A. 4651 to Poopoo to + on stone;
5. $26^{\circ} 56'$ 111.9 feet along Lot 11 to the point of beginning.
