Beginning at a post at the Northwest corner of this lot, on the boundary of the land of Pakini-iki, and on the South side of a 20 foot road, the coordinates of said post referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Aku" being 2693.8 feet North and 1761.6 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2479, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $270^{\circ} 00'$ 709.4 feet along the South side of the 20 foot road to a post;
2. $360^{\circ} 00'$ 510.8 feet along Lot 20 to a post;
3. $90^{\circ} 00'$ 613.3 feet along Lot 24 to a post;
4. $163^{\circ} 45'$ 419.0 feet along the land of Pakini-iki to a + on set stone and ahu;
5. $191^{\circ} 03'$ 110.5 feet along the land of Pakini-iki to the point of beginning.
