Beginning at a "W" in bed rock of stream at the West corner of this lot and the South corner of Lot 1 and on the boundary between Kaunamano and Kahilipali-nui, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kapuna" being 5158.0 feet North and 3197.5 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2340, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 240° 22' 2062.0 feet along Lot 1 to a pipe;
2. 318° 30' 1530.0 feet along Government land to + on set stone;
3. 58° 40' 1380.0 feet along Lot 4 and across 40 foot road to + on set stone;
4. 354° 35' 63.0 feet along West side of road to + on stone in center of stream;
5. Thence westerly up along center of stream to + on bed rock in stream the direct azimuth and distance being 86° 17' 704.0 feet;
6. Thence northerly up along center of stream along the land of Kahilipali-nui to the point of beginning the direct azimuth and distance being: 135° 35' 1331.0 feet.

Area 69.1 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a roadway 25 feet wide through this lot (0.9 Acre) leaving an area of 68.2 Acres.
