Beginning at a post at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Southwest corner of Lot 18, and on the East side of a 30 foot road, the coordinates of said post referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Aku" being 2856.4 feet North and 519.7 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2479, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 270° 00' 662.3 feet along Lot 18 to a post on the West boundary of Grant 2117 to Mose Kekai;
2. 347° 34' 808.1 feet along Grant 2117 to Mose Kekai to a post;
3. 123° 35' 936.8 feet along the Northeast side of the 30 foot road to a post;
4. 168° 20' 276.7 feet along the East side of the 30 foot road to the point of beginning.
