Beginning at a post at the Southeast corner of this lot, and the North boundary of Lot 29 and the South side of a 20 foot road, the coordinates of said post referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Aku" being 1472.9 feet North and 1051.4 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2479, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 90° 00' 406.0 feet along Lot 29 to a post on the boundary of the land of Pakini-iki;
2. 163° 45' 740.7 feet along the land of Pakini-iki to a post;
3. 270° 00' 613.3 feet along Lot 19 to a post;
4. 360° 00' 711.3 feet along Lots 20, 25 and the 20 foot road to the point of beginning.
