Beginning at a + on a stone at the Northeast corner of this lot and on the West side of Kamane Road and the South side of 10 Foot Right-of-Way to rice fields, from which Government Survey Trig. Station "Pine" is by true azimuth and distance $174^{\circ} 13'$ 1646.0 feet and the Church Spire is $45^{\circ} 55' 30''$, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2464, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $27^{\circ} 09'$ 80.4 feet along Kamane Road to + on stone;
2. $5^{\circ} 47'$ 176.6 feet along Kamane Road to + on stone;
3. $40^{\circ} 52'$ 348.0 feet along Kamane Road to + on stone;
4. $216^{\circ} 36'$ 289.7 feet along Lot 6;
5. $193^{\circ} 46'$ 35.5 feet along Lot 6;
6. $175^{\circ} 06'$ 125.2 feet along Lot 6;
7. $190^{\circ} 08'$ 126.6 feet along Lot 6;
8. $273^{\circ} 37'$ 89.5 feet along the Right-of-Way to the point of beginning.
