Beginning at a + on a stone at the North corner of this lot, the West corner of Lot 26, the Northwest corner of L.C.A. 4694B:1 to Lonoiki, and on the East side of Kamane Road, from which Government Survey Trig. Station "Pine" is by true azimuth and distance $171^{\circ} 03' 30''$ 1598.3 feet and the Church Spire is $46^{\circ} 22' 30''$, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2464, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $13^{\circ} 42'$ 82.5 feet along L.C.A. 4694B:1 to Lonoiki;
2. $283^{\circ} 42'$ 132.0 feet along L.C.A. 4694B:1 to Lonoiki;
3. $79^{\circ} 36'$ 110.2 feet along Lots 29 and 28;
4. $80^{\circ} 47'$ 82.5 feet along L.C.A. 4777:2 to Nukuwaiki;
5. $209^{\circ} 17'$ 165.6 feet along Kamane Road to the point of beginning.
