Beginning at a post at the Northwest corner of this lot and the Northeast corner of Lot 3 and on the South side of a homestead road, the coordinates of said post referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Pahiha" being: 2047.4 feet North and 875.6 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2498, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 270° 07' 475.0 feet along South side of homestead road to a post;
2. 274° 16' 866.25 feet along South side of homestead road to post;
3. 262° 39' 30" 598.85 feet along South side of homestead road to a post;
4. 263° 56' 30" 196.85 feet along South side of homestead road to a post; at the Northwest corner of Government Reserve.
5. 353° 39' 139.5 feet along Government Reserve to a post 10 feet from the edge of ~~the~~ stream;
6. Westerly along a line parallel to and 10 feet from the edge of the stream to a post, the direct azimuth and distance being: 65° 20' 2324.9 feet;
7. 178° 23' 1077.4 feet along Lot 3 across a stream to the point of beginning.
