Lepoia-Kauniho Homesteads,  
North Hilo, Hawaii.

Beginning at a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe at the South corner of this lot, the East corner of Lot 3, and on the North side of Kauniho Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Honohina<sup>(Old)</sup>" being 644.7 feet South and 5883.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2588, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 152° 09' 1549.3 feet along Lot 3 to a 1" galvanized iron pipe;
2. 228° 00' 55.9 feet along Grant 3372 to J. Coeper to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
3. 305° 40' 1560.0 feet along flume right-of-way;
4. 329° 45' 169.5 feet along flume right-of-way;
5. 62° 21' 756.9 feet along North side of Kauniho Road to the point of beginning.
