Railroad Right-of-way (20 feet wide) thru Kapaa Rice and Kula Lot 2-B, Kapaa, Puna, Kauai, the center line of which is described as follows:-

Beginning at the boundary between Rice and Kula Lots 2-A and 2-B, the azimuth and distance to a 1½ inch galvanized iron pipe at an angle in the West boundary of said Lot 2-B being 86° 36' 147.7 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2583, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 131° 59' 133.3 feet to point of curve;
2. Thence along a curve to the right with a radius of 287.94 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being: 164° 25' 308.8 feet;
3. 196° 51' 96.2 feet to point of curve;
4. Thence along a curve to the left with a radius of 846.0 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being: 170° 52' 741.3 feet;
5. 144° 53' 34.0 feet to the East side of Kanaele Road, the azimuth and distance to an angle in said road being: 7° 15' 22.6 feet.
