Beginning at the Northeast corner of this lot and Southeast corner of Lot 2, on the West bank of the Hanalei River, the coordinates from Government Survey Trig. Station "Paina" being N. 1122.4 feet and E. 1018.5 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2262, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $25^{\circ} 41'$  44.2 feet along the West bank of the Hanalei River;
2.  $10^{\circ} 55'$  240.8 feet along the West bank of the Hanalei River;
3.  $357^{\circ} 05'$  171.6 feet along the West bank of the Hanalei River;
4.  $92^{\circ} 35'$  280.0 feet along Government Land;
5.  $166^{\circ} 54'$  280.0 feet along Government Land;
6.  $263^{\circ} 12'$  229.9 feet along Lot 2;
7.  $171^{\circ} 02'$  136.2 feet along Lot 2;
8.  $269^{\circ} 49'$  192.2 feet along Lot 2 to the initial point.

Area  $2\text{-}\frac{7}{10}$  Acres.

Reserving a right of way along **kuaunas** across said lot.
