Beginning at a concrete pillar at seashore at the West corner of this lot, and the North corner of Lot 38, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Anaehoomalu" being 8644.8 feet South and 4090.1 feet West, and running by true azimuths:-

1. Along seashore at highwater mark, to a point of land called Makaha, the direct azimuth and distance being: $228^{\circ} 45'$ 620.0 feet;
2. Thence still along seashore at highwater mark, to the Northwest corner of Lot 40, the direct azimuth and distance being: $256^{\circ} 08'$ 1009.0 feet;
3. $344^{\circ} 05'$ 550.7 feet along Lot 40 along stonewall to a mound of stones at end of stonewall;
4. $74^{\circ} 15'$ 1423.0 feet along remainder of Puuanahulu to a mound of stones at end of stonewall;
5. $139^{\circ} 05'$ 347.7 feet along Lot 38 to the point of beginning.
