Beginning at a + on set stone and ahu on the West boundary of this lot, and at an angle in the boundary of the land of Pakini-iki, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Aku" being 2059.3 feet South and 2220.2 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2479, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $219^{\circ} 41'$ 234.3 feet along the land of Pakini-iki to a post;
2. $270^{\circ} 00'$ 1584.2 feet along Lot 36 to a post on the West side of a 30 foot road;
3. $32^{\circ} 26'$ 325.0 feet along the 30 foot road to a + on set stone;
4. $2^{\circ} 06'$ 600.0 feet along the 30 foot road to a post;
5. $90^{\circ} 00'$ 1657.7 feet along Lots 49 and 48 to a post;
6. $189^{\circ} 50'$ 704.2 feet along the land of Pakini-iki to the point of beginning.
