Beginning at a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe at the South corner of this lot on the Northwest boundary of Lot 3, and at the end of a 30 foot branch road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalaniala" being 9366.2 feet North and 2115.3 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $121^{\circ} 00'$ 1297.8 feet along end of branch road and Lot 5 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe at top of East edge of Keahua Gulch;
2. $190^{\circ} 00'$ 70.9 feet along top of East edge of Keahua Gulch to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
3. $214^{\circ} 33'$ 130.0 feet along same;
4. $258^{\circ} 00'$ 100.0 feet along same;
5. $211^{\circ} 00'$ 342.0 feet along same;
6. $301^{\circ} 00'$ 1242.0 feet along Government Reserve to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe;
7. $31^{\circ} 00'$ 606.0 feet along Northwest side of Lot 3 to the point of beginning.
