Beginning at a post at the Southwest corner of this lot and the Northwest corner of Lot 52, and on the Northeast side of a 30 foot road, the coordinates of said post referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Aku" being 2802.9 feet South and 685.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2479, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $140^{\circ} 30'$ 1205.0 feet along the Northeast side of the 30 foot road to a post;
2. $270^{\circ} 00'$ 1589.0 feet along a 20 foot road and Lot 40 to a post;
3. $360^{\circ} 00'$ 930.0 feet along Lot 45 to a post;
4. $90^{\circ} 00'$ 822.7 feet along Lot 52 to the point of beginning.
